





Supplemental Figure 1. Baseline anxiety levels for students at U1 (Panel A) and U2 (Panel B). Values are the estimated mean Likert responses for female (light gray bars) and male (dark gray bars) students from pre-semester surveys inquiring about levels of four types of anxiety. Estimates were obtained as extended marginal means from linear mixed-effects models. At U2, the significant effect of a student's final grade for the course was incorporated by calculating the means based on the mean score for the class (72.5%). General and Test anxiety instruments were on a 7-point Likert scale, with a value of 4 indicating neutrality; Social and Communication anxiety instruments used a 5-point scale with 3 indicating neutrality. Error bars represent the 95% confidence interval of the estimate, and asterisks indicate significant differences between male and female responses (*, p < 0.05; ***, p < 0.001).



Supplemental Figure 2. Differences in baseline anxiety based on student academic performance. Baseline anxiety responses from pre-semester surveys at U2 were significantly related to the score a student would ultimately earn in the course. Asterisks above individual bars indicate a significantly non-zero slope of the regression of final grade on Likert response; asterisks above a line connecting two bars indicate a significant difference between the slopes for male and female students. *, p < 0.05; ***, p < 0.001. Error bars indicate the 95% confidence interval of the slope estimate.



Supplemental Figure 3. Effects of demographics on U2 student anxiety responses to pedagogical techniques. A) Both male and female U2 students who ultimately earned lower scores in the course were more likely to report higher anxiety levels related to all pedagogical techniques surveyed (e.g. Fig. 1), but the slope for male students was significantly more negative than for female students. B) First-generation female students reported significantly higher anxiety levels related to pedagogical techniques than returning female students as well as all male students. There was no impact of first-generation status on reported male anxiety levels. Error bars represent the 95% confidence interval of the LME estimate. ***, p < 0.001; n.s., not significant.
